Suggested Criteria	Action Taken	Date Completed
Regularly monitor and review water use to check for hidden leaks <i>E.g. By using a spreadsheet to compare water use each month</i>		
Check bills for allowances <i>E.g. Non return to sewer, rateable/ domestic allowance</i>		
Regularly check premises for visible leaks, leaky taps, running toilets etc		
Install water saving devices or invest in new technology <i>E.g. Hippo bags, sensor taps</i>		
Appoint a Water Champion to monitor water use throughout your business/farm/organisation		
Introduce water recycling measures <i>E.g. Rainwater harvesting and grey water recycling</i>		
Advise employees through awareness raising campaign on water efficiency <i>E.g. Lunchtime talks, poster campaigns, incentives</i>		
Create a water management plan or water balance diagram for your business, farm or organisation		
Act as role model for water efficiency throughout your sector <i>E.g. By telling others about the gains you have made by reducing water use</i>
