<b>Ballymoney Food Bank</b>	Operating Tuesday mornings and Friday afternoons. Have widened support network to include all people struggling. No donations needed at present.
<b>Bangor Food Bank</b>	Still operating. No donations needed at present but likely change in 2 weeks' time.

<b>The Larder, St Christopher's Church, Belfast</b>	Still operating Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Donations needed. (Pasta, pasta sauces, long life milk, tinned food, veg, etc.)
