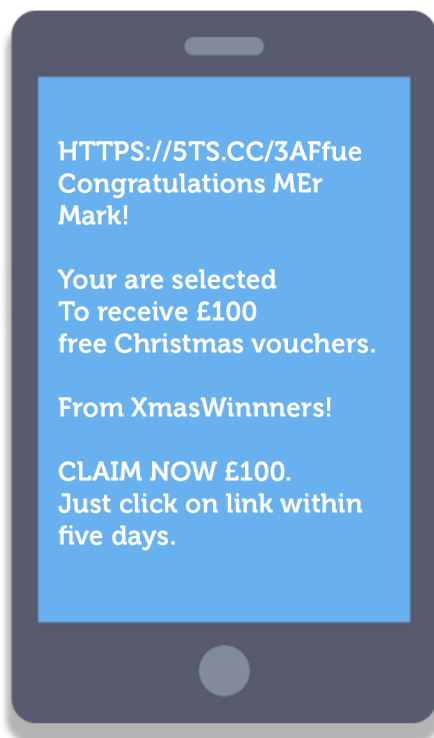

Scam Text

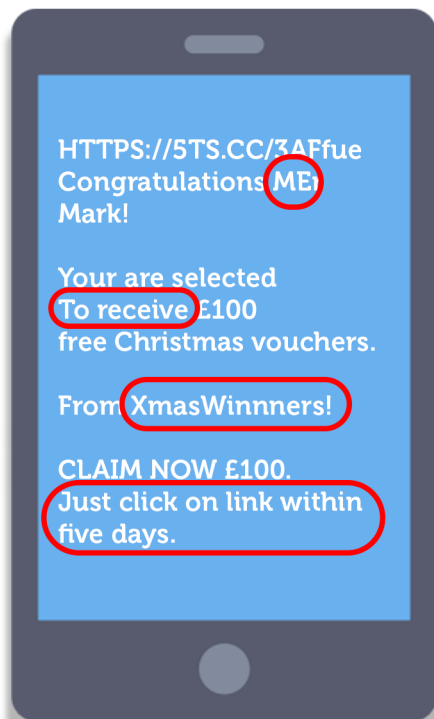


Email Scam



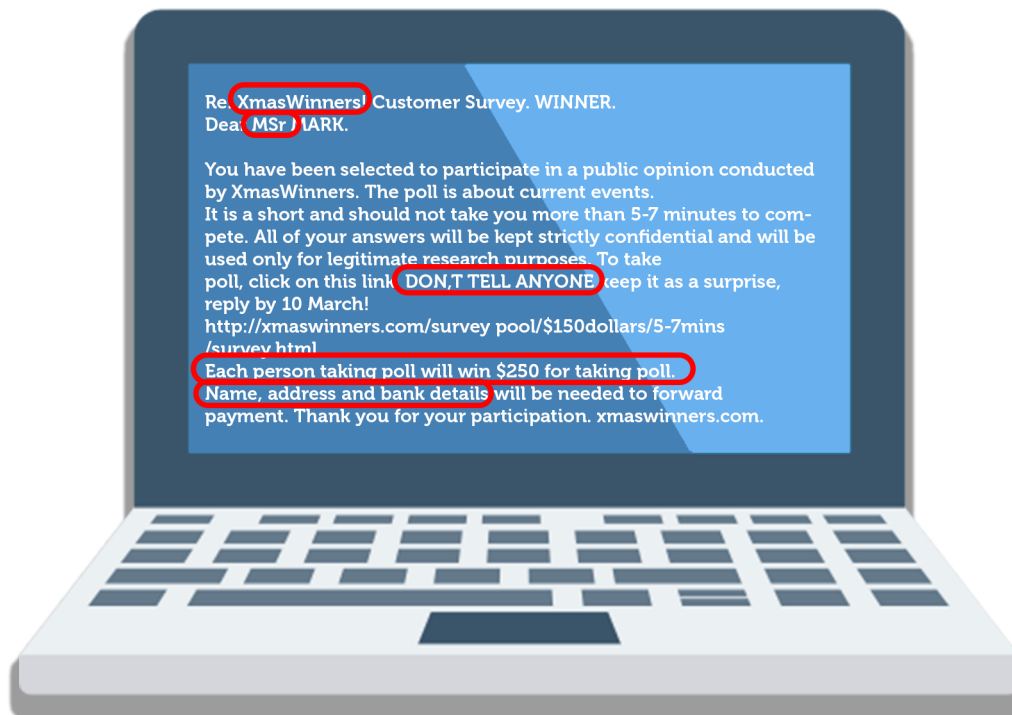

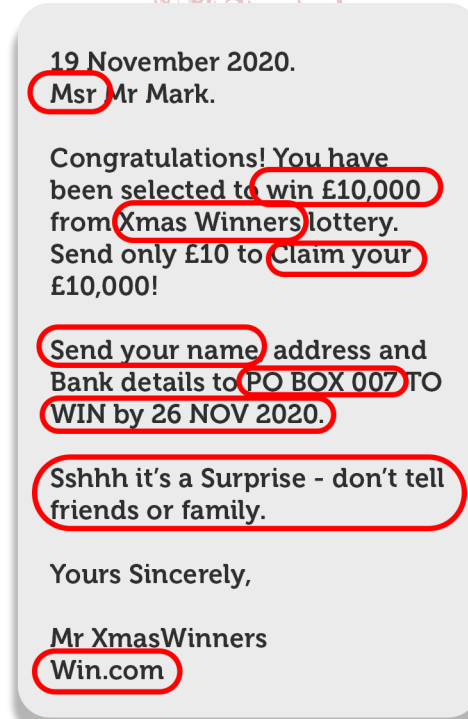
## Scam Text

- (1) Bad Spelling.
- (2) Have you entered the competition?
- (3) Have you heard of the company?
- (4) Puts you under pressure to reply quickly.



## Email Scam

- (1) Have you heard of the company?
- (2) Bad Spelling.
- (3) Asks you not to tell anyone.
- (4) Sounds too good to be true.
- (5) Asks for personal details to claim prize.



## Letter Scam

- (1) Bad Spelling.
- (2) Prize is too good to be true.
- (3) Have you entered the competition?
- (4) Asks you to send money to claim your prize.
- (5) Asks for personal details.
- (6) Uses a general address like a PO Box.
- (7) Puts you under pressure to reply quickly.
- (8) Asks you to keep it a secret.
- (9) Have you heard of the company?
