Quinn Insurance Group has been placed into administration at the High Court in Dublin. Joint administrators were appointed after the Financial Regulator expressed serious concerns about the finances of the company and how it was being run.

How are Northern Ireland customers affected?

- Existing policyholders are not affected. They are still covered, their policy is valid and will be until the end date of their policy.
- They can still make claims in the normal way and should continue to pay their direct debits and premiums.
- The Financial Regulator confirmed on 29 April 2010 that, it has permitted the re-opening of private motor business for both new and existing customers.
